Das Awkscht Fescht Arts and Crafts Show August 2, 3 & 4, 2024 Summary of Rules and Regulations

- 1. Vendors may set up displays on **Thursday**, **August 1**st, **from 10:00 a.m to 6:00 p.m**. Also, set up can be completed on **Friday**, **August 2**nd, **from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m**.
- 2. Vendors are responsible for supplying your own display equipment, including pop-up canopies and/or similar structure. In case of inclement weather, exhibitors should be prepared with rain covers, tie-downs and weights (recommend 40 lbs. per canopy leg).
- 3. Tables should be draped on all sides with NO boxes showing.
- 4. DAF does not provide electric*. You may bring battery operated equipment, including battery operated power inverter. Electrical cords used in conjunction with power inverters must be in good repair. Generators are not allowed. (* a limited number of spaces in the Park's pavilions do include electric and are available, for a higher rental rate, on a first come, first served basis).
- 5. All exhibits must be open from:

12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Friday 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.

Late arrival or earlier breakdown will result in not being invited next year.

- 6. Each exhibitor may park ONE car on the grounds. You will be directed to the designated vendor parking area. Other vehicles may be parked, free of charge, at the volunteer parking area opposite the Lehigh Street Gate #5. No vehicles may be parked near the exhibitor's pavilions or tents. (you can't sell if the customers can't see the booths) We appreciate your help in unloading, parking, then returning to set up.
- Please put your Arts and Crafts parking pass on the left corner of your vehicle's dashboard with your name and booth location clearly visible. There will be a checklist at the gate to ensure each booth has only one vehicle. There can be NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 8. NO SMOKING in the building/pavilions/tents due to fire regulations.
- 9. Discarded cardboard boxes must be flattened before disposing.
- 10. In case of emergency, or to contact one of the Arts and Crafts Committee members, please go to the information booth (the small wooden building located near the end of the Arts and Crafts tents, near where the antique cars enter the park). The information booth can contact emergency services and the A&C committee members by radio.

Please use GATE #6 to enter the grounds. The entrance is located on Route 100, at Macungie Animal Hospital approximately 100 yards north of the Main Entrance.
<u>Please do not enter at the Main Entrance</u> as that gate is reserved strictly for show cars. GATE #6 is the only gate you may use the days of the show!!
